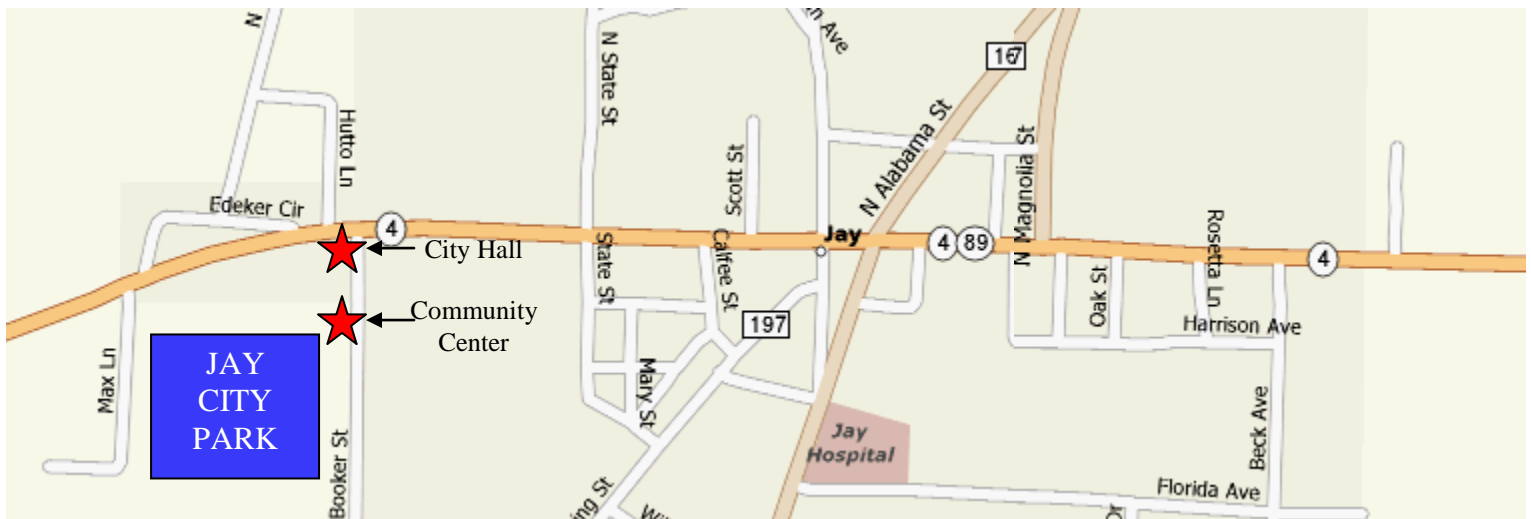


Managers,

On behalf of Tri-County Little League, I would like to welcome you all to the 11-12 year old Little League Baseball Tournament! We wish all teams the best of luck, and hope that you enjoy your visits to our area.

There will be a mandatory managers and coaches meeting on Monday, June 29, 2009 at 3:00 p.m. at the Jay Community Center. It is located directly behind Jay City Hall, adjacent to the park. All park and tournament rules will be discussed at the managers and coaches meeting.

The tournament will be played at Jay City Park. The park doesn't have an exact address, but you can find directions on Jay Recreation Association's website: www.jayrecreation.com.

Basic Information

- ✧ Please have your team there one hour prior to your game. The home team will occupy the third base dugout. The Visiting team will take infield 20 minutes before game time for 7-8 minutes. The Home team will take infield starting 12 minutes before game time for 7-8 minutes.
- ✧ Fields 1 and 2 are going to be the main playing fields. These fields are off-limits to use for warm-up. There are three other fields that can be used for warm-up, and we also have two batting cages. All of these are a first-come, first serve basis. We ask that you please be courteous to others.
- ✧ There will be a concession stand open at all times during the tournament. No coolers are allowed except one team cooler, which each team must provide.
- ✧ The Umpire will check all equipment prior to games – Please have your equipment out for inspection as soon as you enter the dugout. Any faulty equipment will be immediately removed from the field. No painted helmets, or helmets with stickers applied to them will be allowed.
- ✧ No flash photography. Electronic communication devices may not be used on the field or dugouts by the manager, coaches or players -- Little League Rule
- ✧ Alcohol and pets are prohibited. Smoking is allowed **ONLY** in the parking lots.
