A little bit about

Rachel Folden



Reigning National Pro Fastpitch Offensive Player of the Year Rachel Folden and Assistant coach for the Valparaiso University Crusader softball program in 2011. In her role, Folden is responsible for working directly with pitchers, catchers and outfielders.

Folden was the seventh overall draft pick in the 2008 NPF Draft by the Chicago Bandits and made an immediate impact in her first season, helping the Bandits win the NPF Championship. The catcher earned Rookie of the Year honors after hitting .311 with 11 home runs and 32 RBIs, all three of which ranked among the league's top-six performers. In 2009, Folden had another stellar year, hitting .308 with six homers and 22 RBIs, all ranking among the league's top-eight. Last season, Folden was named Worth Offensive Player of the Year in NPF and was the co-winner of the Wilson Home Run Trophy, while also named as the catcher for the All-NPF team, after hitting .316 with 12 home runs and 32 RBIs, leading the league in the latter two categories. She previously spent four years on the Marshall softball team, earning NFCA All-American honors all four seasons while twice being named Conference USA Player of the Year.
