- CHEER for good plays made by BOTH teams.
- Remember—these are CHILDREN playing a GAME.
- Be positive, this is a VOLUNTEER activity for your child.
- Set a GOOD EXAMPLE for your child and his/her teammates.
- Refrain from commenting on the shortcomings of ANY players.
- Do not question or comment on any calls made by the OFFICIALS.
- Please SUPPORT your child and their team, regardless of the outcome.
- Refrain from instructing or directing any players during the course of a game.
- Do discuss your concerns with your child's coach privately, away from the game.
- Support the coaching staff in their efforts to have a POSITIVE & ENJOYABLE experience.

### The Lynbrook / East Rockaway Soccer Parent/Guardian Consent

I/We, the parents (or guardian) of the above named child, hereby give my/our permission for his/her participation in any and all of the activities of the **Lynbrook/East Rockaway Soccer Club** during the current season. I/We assume all the risks and hazards incidental to the conduct of the activities and transportation to and from the activities. I/We do further hereby release, absolve, indemnify, and hold harmless the **Lynbrook/East Rockaway Soccer Club**, the organizer, sponsors, and the supervisors, any or all of them. In case of injury to my/our child, I/we hereby waive all claims against the organizers, the sponsors or any of the supervisors appointed by them. I/We authorize the club to contact my/our family doctor as listed above in the event that I/We or the alternate are not available. Further, I/we authorize the Club to transport my/our child to the doctor's office, if necessary.

EVERYONE (players, coaches, parents, friends, etc.) associated with the Club is hereby informed that poor sportsmanship and inappropriate behavior will NOT be tolerated. Treat all Club and League officials, referees, and opposing coaches, players, & parents with respect at all times. If anyone on the sidelines is abusive in ANY way towards the referee, any coaches, other parents, other players, etc., a Club representative will ask you to leave the field. If you do not leave the field, your child MAY not be allowed to continue playing, and you may then be asked not to attend any further games, and will be subject to probation or expulsion from the Club.

I/WE understand that once my child is registered for the season and placed on a roster, there will be no refunds unless there is no team formed in the registered player's age group.

### ANNUAL REGISTRATION

**Beginning with the Fall 2008 Season**, the previous semi-annual Intramural Registrations will be eliminated (except for Kindergarten/U6 Division), and replaced with an Annual Intramural Registration, which will be held in June. **This Annual Registration will be for a Full-Year Membership**, and will include both the Fall and Spring Seasons.

**\*\*\*THERE WILL NO LONGER BE A SEPARATE REGISTRATION PERIOD FOR SPRING SOCCER\*\*\***

The Annual Registration fee will be provided at a discounted rate from the previous Fall + Spring season registration totals. New residents or other players who do not sign up in June, but wish to play Spring 2009 Soccer, will be placed on a waiting list, and will be accepted only as replacements for players who do not return in the Spring, and will be charged the full-year registration fee. Kindergarten/U6 Division applicants will be given the option to register for a full year, or for ½ year (Fall or Spring season).
