- **Spacious dugouts** (not blocking spectator viewing!)
- **Concrete walkways** (imagine no more mud puddles!)

Yet, three important steps remain to make both fields ready for try-outs on March 7 & 8 and opening day, April 7:

- **Construction of four dugout roofs** (dry players and coaches!)
- **Purchase of four new bleachers** (forty-one fans per set!)
- **Installation of new field mix** (better all-weather surfaces!)

The purchase of materials and products to complete these three steps will cost **\$12,000**.
