Howard Kobata, who has over 20 years of experience as an accomplished fastpitch softball coach in California winning several national and state girl's fastpitch titles, brings his aggressive, defensive style of softball to this clinic. Howard's unique defensive style teaches fundamentals utilizing body weight, position and momentum to achieve speed and quickness. He believes that the entire body can help make a faster and more accurate throw rather than relying on arm strength alone. He is open to new ideas and techniques from other coaches and is excited about sharing his own ideas and techniques to help softball players become quicker, more aggressive and confident in their defensive skills.

Howard's coaching accomplishments include: two Southern California State Championships, a ASA National Championship, a Top 10 finish 3 out of 3 times at Nationals, a 16U ASA Southern California Championship 1992, a 16U ASA Nationals 9th Place 1992, a 14U ASA Southern California Championship 1995, a 14U ASA National Championship 1995, and a 16U ASA Nationals 3rd Place 1996

Cost is \$70 which includes 2 sessions to help prepare for the High School team tryouts. Howard will cover Defensive Skills to include Footwork and Throwing Fundamentals, Fielding, and a variety of Specialty Techniques during a 4 to 5 hour clinic.
