2. All Team managers and coaches have read, understand, and agree to abide by the rules and regulations as set forth in the current Operational Rules of Pony Baseball, Inc. and SCAA as well as other rules and regulations of the game of baseball/softball.
3. All Team managers and coaches understand that Pony Baseball, Inc. and the SCAA Executive Board may refuse to allow our participation with or without a reason, with or without interviewing team managers, coaches, or parents; and regardless of prior participation in Pony Baseball or SCAA.
4. All Team managers and coaches understand that even if allowed to participate this season, Pony Baseball, Inc. and SCAA are not obligated or required to allow participation next season or in subsequent seasons.
5. IN THE EVENT THAT PARTICIPATION IN PONY BASEBALL AND SCAA IS EVER TERMINATED AFTER IT HAS BEGUN, I HEREBY WAIVE ANY LEGAL CLAIM AGAINST PONY BASEBALL, INC. AND SCAA OR ITS BOARD MEMBERS ARISING IN ANY MATTER FROM THE FACT OR METHOD OF TERMINATION.
6. All Team managers and coaches hereby grant SCAA permission to investigate this application for participation as they see fit, without limitation and including the right to speak to references listed or unlisted and previously coached players' parents.
7. All Team managers and coaches have read, understand, and agree to SCAA BY-LAWS, League rules, Pony Baseball, Inc. rules, and SCAA operational guidelines. All Team managers and coaches have read and agree to follow SCAA coaches' ethics and rules.
8. This application must be signed and include the following prior to acceptance
 - a. SCAA Coaches application for all "on field" coaches
 - b. Team Roster to include player name, parents names, contact numbers, age, DOB, Spring SCAA Team
 - c. Player's Sunday Select Letter of commitment
 - d. Player Parent Release Form
9. Team field usage will be assigned by the Sunday Select Director, or VP of Baseball, or League President only. Field usage is not guaranteed and may be rescheduled to support SCAA recreational league requirements. The league will attempt to provide reasonable notice when field usage is not available.

Sunday Select Rules- 2008

Approved by the Board on 22 April 08



The Select program is offered by SCAA, so that those players wishing to experience a higher competitive level may do so. This program is a supplemental program to our normally provided Recreational program.

1. All Teams must be registered, have turned in a roster and paid all fees through the Select Field Director to be recognized as a SCAA Sunday Select team. The Season for Sunday Select will be August 31 till May 31.
2. Sunday Select teams must hold open tryouts for at **least** 25% of the roster.
3. All (100%) of Select players for baseball must be registered and participating on an SCAA Recreational team for the spring season. Participation in the fall season is optional. All (100%) of Select players for softball must be registered and participating on an SCAA Recreational team for the fall season. Participation in the spring season is optional. For Baseball if a player joins the select team after the spring season for baseball and after the fall season for softball they must register SCAA and pay the current recreational season player fee
4. Select participants will complete all of their commitments to the SCAA Recreational League before participating in any Select events. (i.e. monies paid, All Star Commitments, etc.)
5. All Select participants, Managers and Coaches must have a signed commitment letter on file with the Select Field Director before they can participate in Select events.
6. All Select teams will be associated with the same baseball governing body as the SCAA associated leagues. Membership in other baseball associations is strictly a separate cost to be paid by the Select players, and not part of the SCAA registration fees. Any Select team with an affiliation other than SCAA will not be recognized as a Select team for field usage. These teams must put in a field rental request to the SCAA Board.
7. Select Team players, coaches and parents are subject to the same rules, codes of conduct and restrictions that apply to Pony Rules and SCAA league players and parents.
8. If any Select team is found in anyway bypassing, abusing or not obeying SCAA rules & guidelines then at the discretion of the SCAA board that team may be dissolved immediately. In these situations no reimbursement of SCAA fees or funds will be granted to the Select team.
9. The minimum or maximum amount of players for each team will be as per Pony Tournament Guidelines.

10. Team fee for use of the complex and field from Aug 31 to May 31 will be based on 12 players at 50% of the spring season registration fee for the age group of the team. (Example: Pony Select team – $12 \times 95.00 \times 0.5 = \570.00) Team fee is due by Aug 15th.
- 10a. Teams formed after Aug 31 must pay a monthly prorated fee based on the above team fee divided by 9 months X the # of remaining months to Sept 1st.
(Example: Pony Select team starts April 1st – 570.00 team fee / 9 months in season X 5 months April-Aug = $\$317.00$)
11. Managers and coaches will submit each year an application to coach a Sunday Select team and will be approved by the Board. Managers, coaches and parent volunteers must have an approved application on file with the SCAA Board
12. All games and practices must be scheduled through the Sunday Select Field Director. SCAA Recreational make-up games will take precedent over any scheduled Select function. SCAA will make the complex available from for all months except from the end of SCAA Spring Season till the end of the use for All Stars (approximately mid August). Fields will be available on Fridays from 5 till 9 PM during the season for practice and Sundays 12 till 6 for games.
13. All costs, such as, baseballs, equipment, umpires and field maintenance, will be the explicit responsibility of the Select team. Teams may use there signed out SCAA equipment.
14. Field Maintenance must be performed after the last practice on Friday nights and after Sunday Games to include: emptying all trash cans, dragging and lining the field, and cleaning the restrooms. Failure to do so could result in the loss of field usage or fines.
15. Sunday Select managers should not schedule any tournaments from mid June till mid August to allow players to participate, if chosen, in the All Stars teams. All Stars will take precedence over Sunday Select events.
16. Uniform costs are the responsibility of each team. Uniforms may be purchased from SCAA vendors with any league volume or discount available to SCAA. SCAA logo will be purchased by SCAA and worn by all teams on their respective uniforms.
17. Teams will not have use of the concession stand, unless specifically approved by the head on the concessions and President.
18. Teams are responsible for complex security (i.e. locking buildings and gates)
19. Team players will be allowed to have no more than five events per week. This will include SCAA recreational practices and games. All pitching requirements and rules must be complied with. During spring season for baseball recreational pitching take priority.

20. There will be no more than two Sunday Select teams per division. Teams will follow Pony age guidelines.

21. Usage of field lights is prohibited unless scheduled in advance and a lighting fee of \$20 per hour is paid to SCAA (except Friday practices)

SCAA provides the Sunday Select program as an adjunct to the SCAA PONY Recreational League. The Recreational League will remain the primary focus of SCAA.

For your child to participate in the Sunday Select Program, a parent or guardian must sign this commitment agreement.

I understand for my child _____ to participate in the SCAA Sunday Select Program, I must agree to the following:

1. My child will be registered and participate in the Spring Season of the SCAA PONY Recreational League.
2. If chosen at the end of the season by the SCAA managers as an All Star, and my child decides to participate it will be under the current All-Star rules.
3. If my child leaves a Sunday Select team, they are ineligible to join another Sunday Select team until the following season. The season runs Aug 31 thru to May 3rd .
4. I understand Sunday Select teams are financially responsible for all of their own expenses and I will be incurring additional fees for this program. Amount of fees are determined by each team and paid to the team's business manager.
5. My child will fill all Recreational League requirements before participating in any Sunday Select event, including All-Stars.
6. By participating in Sunday Select my child could have up to a maximum of five (5) combined events per week. Parents are responsible to monitor and limit their child's innings pitched to the Pony regulations. Rec League pitching takes precedence and must not be impeded by Sunday Select team participation
7. Failure to abide by these rules could forfeit my child's eligibility in the SCAA organization.
