Season Plans for 2010-11: All teams will be scheduled for 2 practices per week and can expect 4-8 weeks during the season in which they will have 3 practices. In addition, we are continuing the successful Goalie Development program providing professional goalie instruction to all dedicated and backup goalies, as well as our popular events with the UNION College Hockey teams: the Charity 3v3 Tournament, SYHA nights at UNION games, and the annual Pasta Dinner and Skate with the Dutchmen and Dutchwomen. In addition, we plan to continue our tradition of offering a home tournament or jamboree for all levels of our Association.

Association-wide Fundraiser: Each year, SYHA sponsors one mandatory fundraising event. Once again this year, each player will receive a credit for a total of 8 adult tickets to Union College Hockey Games, which may be re-sold to the public or kept for personal use. The Association will receive 50% of ticket costs. The proceeds from this event are used to reduce registration fees and enhance our programming.

Team Assessments and Fundraisers: Team expenses are not included in the Basic Registration Fee and are the responsibility of individual teams. Proceeds from team fundraising can offset team expenses, provided all team members have the opportunity to benefit equally. When necessary, the team representative will collect assessments from team members for the following types of expenses: referee fees for home games, tournament entrance fees, lodging during away tournaments for a non-parent coaches, etc. Team reps will report to the team members on all moneys collected and spent at certain intervals during the season.

Mandatory Parental Support: SYHA has *mandatory* requirements of parental participation in support of all of our youth programs. Participation is part of each family's obligation to their team. SYHA families may be assigned "slots" to work during SYHA games, practices, and tournaments. Assignments may include but are not limited to scorekeeper, timekeeper, and penalty box official.

SYHA Policies Available on Web: The Schenectady Youth Hockey Association adheres to the USA Hockey Zero Tolerance Policy and the USA Hockey Code of Conduct for players, spectators, and coaches. SYHA Refund Policy:

A full refund of registration fees, regardless of reason, may be requested for Squirt A Travel, PeeWee, or Bantam registration fees paid prior to signing a player commitment form, or May 9th, 2010, whichever is earlier.

A full refund of registration fees, regardless of reason, may be requested for Cross-Ice Mites or Travel Mite registration fees paid until Monday, October 4, 2010.

A full refund of registration fees, regardless of reason, may be requested for Squirt Garnet/White registration fees paid until Monday, October 18, 2010.

The following refund policy takes effect after the dates specified above:

- a. All requests for refunds must be made in writing to the Registrar, and are to be presented by the Division Director and approved or denied by the SYHA Board of Directors at the next regular meeting of the Board. Once approved, refunds will be made within 30 days of approval.
- b. The Board will approve a prorated refund of ice fees, less a \$75 administrative fee, if a request is made because of a medical condition that, in the written opinion of a medical doctor, prohibits the player from participating in hockey for a period of at least 8 weeks.
- c. The Board will approve a prorated refund of ice fees, less a \$75 administrative fee, if a request is made because the player and his/her family are moving from the Capital Region (over 50 miles) during the hockey season.
- d. The Board may approve a prorated refund of ice fees, less a \$75 administrative fee, for reasons other than those stated above, or if another player replaces the departing player and pays the appropriate fees (see SYHA handbook).
