Application/Criteria for APB Scholarship

All applicants must have a cumulative weighted academic GPA of 3.0 or above. A current (unofficial) transcript including first semester senior grades must be attached to the application. All scholarship recipients will be chosen based on their accomplishments as stated on their applications. Depending on the number of applications and the amount of money allocated to each scholarship, less qualified applicants may not receive a scholarship. At the discretion of the scholarship committee, a scholarship may be awarded to a student who meets most, but not all, of the criteria. The following descriptions are a summary of the most pertinent qualifications. Additional factors, not listed here, may be considered.

Scholarships are available to Antelope seniors who plan to continue their education at a four-year college or university, a two-year college, or a vocational school and meet the listed criteria. Parent(s)/guardian(s) of all APB Scholarship applicants **MUST** be an APB member in good standing (paid member) for that current scholarship year. A minimum of one (1), \$500 scholarship will be awarded. More scholarships may be given depending on fund availability.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES: Provide the following information on one or more separate sheets of paper. Give specific details in a concise manner. Your application will be scored for every item on this list. Use the same numbers and the same or similar headings as given here when recording your information. A typed application is preferred, but legible printing is acceptable. List only activities, awards, leadership positions and community involvement accomplished **while in high school**. The first page of your application should include the cover sheet provided with your name, address, phone and email. Please list your name on all pages submitted. The committee will make scholarship decisions based only on your application responses. Applicants won't be interviewed.

Please list and briefly discuss the following items. Some activities may be discussed in more than one area.

- 1. SCHOOL ACTIVITIES:** List and briefly describe your school involvement at Antelope beyond the classroom. This category includes sports, clubs, performing arts, student government, radio, etc. Please include the number of years and which years (9th-12th) you were involved in each activity. Give some indication of the depth of involvement where appropriate (ex. varsity team, office or positions held, committees served, time spent, etc.).
- 2. HONORS AND AWARDS:** List and briefly describe each item, including dates or which grade you were in at the time of the award. Include high school honors and awards, as well as outside achievements.
- 3. LEADERSHIP POSITIONS:** List and briefly describe activities at school and/or within the community in which you have held a leadership position. Include dates or school grade.

4. COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT: List and briefly describe your volunteer work in the community for groups such as church, community organizations, clubs, or non-profit agencies. *In other words, what contributions have you made to society and/or the community outside of Antelope High School? When and how much time did you give to the activity?*

5. ADDITIONAL ACTIVITIES/AREAS OF INTEREST NOT COVERED IN THE ABOVE CATEGORIES – Describe any other activities, experiences, hobbies or other personal areas of interest that could help the committee learn more about you and may assist them in determining why you should receive a scholarship.

6. CAREER GOALS/COLLEGE MAJOR – Briefly discuss what your plans or interests are for college and the future.

7. COLLEGE PLANNING TO ATTEND – What colleges have you applied to? Where have you been accepted? Tell whether these are two-year, four-year or technical/vocational schools.

8. EMPLOYMENT EXPERIENCE – Describe what you have done for pay during your high school years.

9. ACADEMIC GPA & RANK IN CLASS – List your *weighted* GPA, as well as your *weighted* rank (i.e., 25th out of 412) in the senior class. **ATTACH A COPY OF YOUR CURRENT TRANSCRIPT (unofficial is acceptable) WITH FIRST SEMESTER SENIOR GRADES POSTED.** (*Your cumulative weighted academic GPA must be 3.0 or above to apply.*)

10. ESSAY: Write a *maximum 250-word* essay on the following topic: While in high school, what accomplishment are you most proud of and why? (You may discuss an accomplishment having to do with school, community, family or any area of your life.)
