

Binghamton Blizzard



Instructions for Running the Slap-Shot Den at Binghamton Senators Games.

- It is mandatory that at least one adult be present at all times while the Slap-Shot Den is in operation. The adult present during the Slap-Shot Den operation must insure that fans do not touch the Slap-Shot Den and must keep fans away from the rear.
- At least two people need to run the Slap-Shot den. You can get excessively busy at times and two or more people working the den can keep the crowd moving along at a good pace.
- Take enough dollar bills to make change for at least twenty dollars
- You need to be at the Broome Memorial Arena no later than seventy-five minutes before game time (Ex. For the 7:00 games please arrive by 5:45)
- Enter the Broome Memorial Arena via the Press entrance on the first floor of the building. (Washington Street nearest to the new SUNY Building)
- Sign in with the person at the desk and receive Concourse Passes (These passes must be available while you are in the building). You do not have to purchase tickets to the game to run the Slap-Shot Den.
- Take the elevator to the right of the press table up to the second floor. You will be admitted to the Concourse level of the building
- Go to the Fan Zone at Section 15. Tell the person working that you are with the Binghamton Blizzard.
- They will give you a box that contains T-Shirts, sports cards and temporary tattoos (Max and the Senators Logo) and a receipt book.
- Go to the Slap shot den and make certain that the hockey sticks and balls are already there. If the den has not been inflated or the sticks and balls are not there, tell Fan Zone as soon as possible.
- Place the Blizzard banner on the table and hang the other Blizzard posters on the slap shot den. Arrange four to five of the t-shirts on the table Place the temporary tattoos where they cannot be grabbed off of the table
- The prizes are given out as follows:
 - One shot in the goal - Choice of one Temporary Tattoo or sports card
 - Two Shots in the goal - T-shirt
 - Three Shots in the goal - T-shirt or choice of any additional prizes that the Senators may give us
- Small children that take shots on goal automatically get a Max tattoo or card regardless of whether they get a goal or not
- Each person gets three shots for one dollar. If someone pays several dollars at the same time they can get prizes based on the total number of shots that they are allowed. (Ex if someone pays for six shots for two dollars, if they get two or three in the goal during those six shots they are eligible for the t-shirt or other available prizes)
- Your busiest times will be - before the game, during the first and second intermissions
- After the start of the third period, if you are no longer busy, you can close up shop.
- Take the money with you and turn it over to the Senators employee on duty at the Fan Zone. At this time count the money in front of the Senators Employee and obtain a signed receipt (white copy).
- The Senators staff will take care of the den, the sticks and balls
- ⇒ Turn in the cash receipt to Mary Harrison, Blizzard Treasurer or any board member at the next Blizzard practice session
