What's New?

New Divisional Structure for Farm and Minors

The divisions formerly known as Farm and Minors have been replaced by three new divisions—A, AA and AAA. The new structure is intended to provide an improved balance of competition while offering “good fit” options for our players regardless of their skill level. All other divisions will remain intact. Additional information regarding the divisions offered by Cherry Creek Little League is provided in the **Divisions** section of this newsletter.

Mandatory Assessments for All Divisions Above T-Ball

With the divisional changes, the League also has adopted Little League International's requirement that **all players above the T-Ball Division must attend at least one assessment**. In other words, if you are registering a player to participate **in any division other than T-Ball, the player must attend at least one assessment in order to play during the 2012 season**. Team assignments will be based on the assessments as follows:

- Players age 4 will be placed on a T-Ball team.
- Players ages 5 – 6 will be placed on a Single A or T-Ball team.
- Players age 7 will be placed on a Single A or Double A team.
- Players age 8 will be drafted to a Majors 9/10 team or placed on a Double A team.
- Players ages 9 – 10 will be drafted to a Majors 9/10 team or will be placed on a Triple A team.
- Players age 11 will be drafted to a Majors 11/12 team or will be placed on a Triple A team.
- Players age 12 will be drafted to a Majors 11/12 team or can reassess for the Juniors division.
- Players ages 13 – 14 will be drafted to a Seniors or Juniors team or will not participate in 2012.
- Players ages 15 – 16 will be drafted to a Seniors team or will not participate in 2012.

Managers no longer are allowed to bring a pre-formed team into the League.

Registration

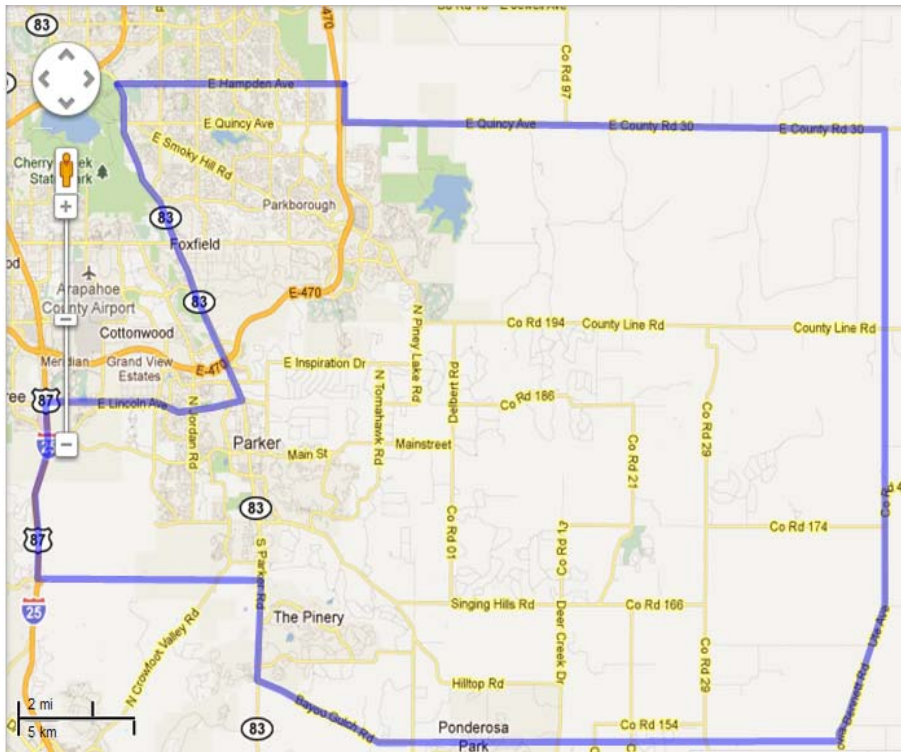
Registration for the 2012 Cherry Creek Little League baseball season is now open. Online registration is available from the League Web site at CherryCreekLL.com and is the preferred method for registering players. The direct link to the registration Web page is <https://rockymountainregister.com/enroll/ccll/login.asp?programid=1>. Alternatively, you may print and complete the application that is included at the end of this newsletter and return it by mail to **Cherry Creek Little League, P.O Box 460639, Aurora, Colorado 80046-0639** or in-person at an assessment.

Regardless of your registration method, you must provide a copy of each player's birth certificate. Online registrants may submit birth certificate copies separately from their registrations by mail to **Cherry Creek Little League, P.O Box 460639, Aurora, Colorado 80046-0639** or in-person at an assessment.

The League offers a **\$20 early registration discount**. There also is a **\$5 multi-player discount** that applies to the second child and any subsequent children for families registering multiple players. The first player does not receive the multi-player discount. Deadlines for each Division's early registration discount are provided to the right.

League Boundaries



Cherry Creek Little League serves children ages 4 through 16 living south of Hampden Avenue, north of Lincoln Avenue and Bayou Gulch and east of Parker Road. Players residing outside these boundaries will be allowed to play in Cherry Creek Little League but cannot participate in post-season All-Star tournaments.

Divisions

The following are brief descriptions of the divisions Cherry Creek Little League offers. Please visit the League Web site at CherryCreekLL.com for more detailed information.

T-Ball Division (Ages 4 through 6—No Assessment Required)

The T-Ball Division provides an instructional setting for young players to learn the fundamentals of baseball. The format for play is a combination of coach pitch and hitting from a batting tee. The season begins in May and is comprised of approximately 15 games, which are played on weekday evenings and Saturdays, primarily at Marina Park (Meadow Point Elementary School). The season concludes in late July. Please refer to the **Calendar of Events** section of this newsletter for pre-season assessment dates.

A Division (Ages 5 through 7—Assessment Required)

The Single A Division provides an instructional setting for young players to learn the fundamentals of baseball or build on the skills they already have acquired. Players ages 5 – 6 should have at least one prior year experience playing baseball or T-Ball. The format for play is a combination of player pitch and coach pitch. The season begins in May and is comprised of approximately 15 games, which are played on weekday evenings and Saturdays, primarily at Spring Creek Park. The season concludes in late July. Please refer to the **Calendar of Events** section of this newsletter for pre-season assessment dates.

AA Division (Ages 7 through 8—Assessment Required)

The Double A Division provides an instructional, yet moderately competitive, setting for young players to learn the fundamentals of baseball or build on the skills they already have acquired. Players who are 7 years old should have at least one prior year experience playing baseball. The format for play follows traditional Little League baseball rules with shortened pitching (42-foot) and base running (50-foot) distances. The season begins in May and is comprised of approximately 15 games, which are played on weekday evenings and Saturdays, primarily at Spring Creek Park. The season concludes in late July. Please refer to the **Calendar of Events** section of this newsletter for pre-season assessment dates.

AAA Division (Ages 9 through 11—Assessment Required)

The AAA Division provides an instructional, yet moderately competitive, setting for players ages 9 through 11 to learn the fundamentals of baseball or build on the skills they already have acquired. The format for play follows traditional Little League baseball rules. The season begins in May and is comprised of approximately 16 – 18 games, which are played on weekday evenings and Saturdays, primarily at Mission Viejo Park. Additional exhibition or tournament games may be played during the regular season schedule. The season concludes in late July.

Majors 9/10 Division (Ages 9 through 10—Assessment Required for Players New to the Division)

The Majors 9/10 Division provides a competitive setting for players to advance their baseball skills. Players interested in participating in the Majors 9/10 Division for the first time and returning players who do not wish to remain “the property” of their previous season’s team must attend a pre-season assessment to gain eligibility for the player draft. Please refer to the ***Calendar of Events*** section of this newsletter for pre-season assessment dates.

The format for play follows traditional Little League baseball rules. The season begins in April and is comprised of approximately 16 – 18 regular season games. Additional exhibition or tournament games may be played during the regular season schedule. Games are played on weekday evenings and Saturdays, primarily at Mission Viejo Park. The regular season concludes in mid-June.

Players in the Majors 9/10 Division are eligible for selection to an All-Star Team that will participate in a post-season tournament at the District level and potentially at the State level in July. ***Any player who lives outside Cherry Creek Little League’s boundaries is ineligible for the All-Star Team.***

Majors 11/12 Division (Ages 11 through 12—Assessment Required for Players New to the Division)

The Majors 11/12 Division provides a competitive setting for players to advance their baseball skills. Players interested in participating in the Majors 11/12 Division for the first time and returning players who do not wish to remain “the property” of their previous season’s team must attend a pre-season assessment to gain eligibility for the player draft. Please refer to the ***Calendar of Events*** section of this newsletter for pre-season assessment dates.

The format for play follows traditional Little League baseball rules for a portion of the season. Cherry Creek Little League will participate in a Little League sanctioned Pilot Program for another portion of the season with a 50-foot pitching distance and 70-foot base paths. This extended field will better prepare players at this level for entry into the Juniors Division. The season begins in April and is comprised of approximately 16 – 18 regular season games. Additional exhibition or tournament games may be played during the regular season schedule. Games are played on weekday evenings and Saturdays, primarily at Mission Viejo Park. The regular season concludes in mid-June.

Players in the Majors 11/12 Division are eligible for selection to an All-Star Team that will participate in post season tournament play at the District level and potentially the State level in July. Regional and National tournaments begin in early August. ***Any player who lives outside Cherry Creek Little League’s boundaries is ineligible for the All-Star Team.***

Junior Division (Ages 13 – 14—Assessment Required for Players New to the Division)

The Junior Division provides a competitive setting for early teen players to advance their baseball skills. Players interested in participating in the Junior Division for the first time and returning players who do not wish to remain “the property” of their previous season’s team must attend a pre-season assessment to gain eligibility for the player draft. Please refer to the ***Calendar of Events*** section of this newsletter for pre-season assessment dates.

The format for play follows traditional baseball rules with 90-foot base paths. The season begins in May and is comprised of approximately 15 – 18 games. Additional exhibition or tournament games may be played during the regular season schedule. Games are played on weekday evenings and Saturdays at a variety of locations. The regular season concludes in late-June.

Players in the Junior Division are eligible for selection to an All-Star Team that will participate in a post-season tournament at the District level and potentially at the State level in July. ***Any player who lives outside Cherry Creek Little League’s boundaries is ineligible for the All-Star Team.***

Senior Division (Ages 15 through 16—Assessment Required for Players New to the Division)

The Senior Division provides a competitive setting for high school players to advance their baseball skills. Players interested in participating in the Senior Division for the first time and returning players who do not wish to remain “the property” of their previous season’s team must attend a pre-season assessment to gain eligibility for the player draft. Please refer to the ***Calendar of Events*** section of this newsletter for pre-season assessment dates.

The format for play follows traditional baseball rules with 90-foot base paths. Practices begin in mid-May, and games begin the first week of June. The season is comprised of approximately 15 – 18 games, and additional exhibition or tournament games may be played during the regular season schedule. Games frequently are played on Saturdays as double-headers, and some games are played on weekday evenings. The Senior Division is an inter-league division with games played at a variety of locations in the metro area. The regular season concludes in July.

Players in the Senior Division are eligible for selection to an All-Star Team that will participate in a post-season tournament at the District level and potentially at the State level in July. ***Any player who lives outside Cherry Creek Little League’s boundaries is ineligible for the All-Star Team.***

Roster Assignments (T-Ball)

Cherry Creek Little League attempts to build ***T-Ball rosters*** based on players’ school or neighborhood proximity. In the event a player wants to be placed on a specific team, play for a specific manager or play with a particular other player, this information should be clearly noted by the parent/guardian on the player’s online registration or paper application.

After ***T-Ball roster*** assignments are complete—typically a week prior to the first practice—players will be contacted by their Team Manager. If a player learns that he or she was not assigned to the desired team, the player’s parent/guardian may ask the Team Manager to transfer or trade the player to the desired team. Both of the Team Managers involved must agree on the trade/transfer and submit a Player Movement Form to the Division Vice President or the Player Agent. **Cherry Creek Little League cannot guarantee the placement of a player on a particular roster.**

Roster placements for all divisions other than T-Ball will be completed via a player draft or via assignment by the Cherry Creek Little League Board of Directors based on the results of the player assessments. **Cherry Creek Little League will not attempt to honor requests for placement on a particular roster for divisions other than T-Ball.**

Volunteers

League Administration

Cherry Creek Little League is a 100% volunteer organization and has multiple key positions available at the League administration level for the 2012 season. Currently, vacancies include the **Division Director posts for most of the League’s divisions**, and assistance is always needed for field maintenance and the League’s concession stand at Mission Viejo. Individuals who wish to volunteer at the League administration level are asked to please attend an upcoming Cherry Creek Little League Board meeting to express their interest. Please refer to the ***Calendar of Events*** section of this newsletter for Board meeting dates.

Managers and Coaches

Individuals who are interested in managing or coaching a team are required to complete the following steps:

1. Submit a coaches’ application to cclapplications@gmail.com.
2. Attend the mandatory coaches’ meeting scheduled for January 20, 2012, at Grandview High School.
3. Submit a volunteer application at the coaches’ meeting.

The above-referenced requirements apply to all Managers and Coaches, **including returning Managers and Coaches**. The volunteer application and coaches application for 2012 are available for download from CherryCreekLL.com.

Team Assistants (Non-Coaching)

Each team will have opportunities for parent/guardian involvement in roles that may include scorekeeper, team parent or pitch counter. Parents/guardians who are willing to serve in these roles should clearly document their interest on their player's online registration or paper application accordingly.

Fundraising

The concession stand at Mission Viejo is Cherry Creek Little League's primary source of fundraising. **All age groups** are required to make a relatively small contribution to the concession stand as described below:

Team managers will provide details regarding the concession stand contribution requirements. The cost of the concession stand contribution is approximately \$6 per player. In addition, each player's family will be expected to volunteer two hours working in the concession stand.

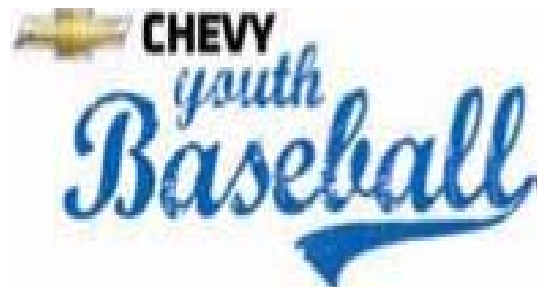
Donations and Sponsorships

Uniform Deposits

All players in all divisions are required to provide their Team Manager with a uniform deposit check in the amount of \$50. **This check will not be deposited** unless the player fails to return his or her uniform to the League within 30 days of the end of the division's season. Checks will be shredded (not returned) after uniforms are accounted for.

It is important that all players provide their Team Manager with the deposit check at the first practice of the season. The Team Manager will not be allowed to pick up the team's uniforms until all deposit checks have been collected. If the Team Manager receives all deposit checks at the first practice of the season, there will be adequate time to address sizing issues that might arise, prior to picture day and the first game of the season.

Required and Optional Equipment

Cherry Creek Little League provides game jerseys, hats, batting helmets and catcher's gear for use during the season. The following are lists of required and optional equipment to be provided by the players in each division.
