

Player Evaluations – When, Where, Who and Why?

Players should bring their glove on Saturday and bat (if you have one) on Sunday. Please wear tennis shoes as we are inside. We will provide baseballs, batting helmets and bat if needed. **Note:** The schedule listed below is only an estimate and we will do our best to stay on time. However, timing is affected by the number of players who participate each year. If you have a conflict with your scheduled time that cannot be resolved, you may arrive at a different time. Otherwise please try and adhere to the schedule.

Who should attend?

12 year olds: those who would like to play in the Majors division and be eligible to play on the District Tournament team should attend both dates.

10 and 11 year olds: All players **must** attend both evaluation dates in order to be eligible for placement in the Majors division and be considered for a District Tournament team unless you have made special arrangements with the league's Player Agent. (See note below) Those players who do not attend will be placed in the AAA division.

9 year olds: **Only** those that are interested in playing in the AAA division should attend the two evaluation dates. Typically these are players that were in the AA division last season. If selected to play in AAA you become eligible to play on a District Tournament team at the end of the season.

NOTE: If you are unable to attend the evaluations on either one or both dates you must make special arrangements with the league's Player Agent.

District Tournament Teams (All Stars)

There will be three teams representing our league again this year. It is possible for the teams to be made up of the following age groups: 9/10, 10/11 and 11/12 year olds. The team rosters are determined through a voting process. The Majors coaches will vote for the 10/11 and 11/12 year old teams. All players in the Majors division will be on the ballot for these two teams. The 10 year olds on this ballot not selected for the 10/11 year old team are given first consideration for the 9/10 year old team. The AAA coaches then vote for the balance of the 9/10 year old team from a ballot made up of all 9 and 10 year olds in the AAA division.

Parents have the right to determine if they want their child involved in tournament play. However, the league reserves the right to determine which team they will be placed on. The goal of tournament play is to field the most competitive team we can at each level. The 11/12 year old age bracket team can advance to the Little League World Series in Williamsport Pennsylvania. The other two teams can advance as far as the State Tournament.

The rosters will be announced sometime after June 15th
