

Information for those who live within the area marked” boundary adjustment” on the advertisement flyers.

This area has now become a part the Central Little League boundary starting with the 2012 season.

How does this affect your family for this year and the years to come?

Those that played in the American League last year, and their siblings are “grandfathered” into the American League for the rest of their little league career if they choose to remain. This means you do have the option to either continue to play in the American League or move over to the Central League starting with the 2012 season (or anytime in the future). **Please note:** when a player does make the choice to move out of the American League they **cannot** return.

Otherwise, as long as there is at least one member of the family that continues to play in the American League from year to year, their younger siblings will remain eligible to play in the American League as they become old enough to do so.
