1. **NO SHOW BUNT THEN SLUG HIT – AUTOMATIC OUT**(pending umpire judgement)
2. Coin toss to determine Home Team. Umpire will determine who calls toss.
3. Continuous Running batting order(if everyone on roster does not bat it is considered batting out of order, penalty applies(ASA Rule 7 section 2).
4. Free substitution to any position but batting order never changes.
5. 10 players on field(10th is an outfielder ONLY), may play nine if both teams agree.
6. 10 run rule applies after 3 ½-4 innings
7. No new innings after 1hr 45 min. of play. Not applied to finals.
8. Points awarded, 2 for win, 1 for tie and 0 for loss
9. Optional courtesy runner can be used for pitcher or catcher. This will be the last person who batted that is not on base.
10. PITCHER; May start with the non-pivot foot on or behind the pitching rubber. May step back with the non-pivot foot before delivery of the pitch. Five practice pitches to start a game then three between innings.
11. 1st and 2nd place bracket winners will play in Sunday championship games. 1st and 2nd place to receive medals for each championship bracket.
12. No infield practice between games.
