CAMP PHILOSOPHY

Our camps are based on the idea that soccer must be a fun experience as well as developmental. Sportsmanship as well as competitiveness must be part of the game. Using our new updated curriculum, our program is designed to meet the needs of players at various levels of ability. Very strong emphasis is placed on the development of skills and their application in game related situations. The use of small-sided games ensures full participation by each player.

REASONABLY PRICED- Cost is \$105.00 per week for each player and a \$10 discount for additional family members. That covers 5 days with 4 hours of instruction per day.

HIGH-LEVEL INSTRUCTION/ROLE MODELS-Staff, which relates well with players, now includes teachers from our local schools who are coaching soccer at the High School level as well as advanced college players who have all played in our league. All coaches have a coaching license and have gone through the risk management screening.

IDEAL RATIOS-Coach to player ratio is typically 1 coach to 8-9 players.

IDEAL DIVISIONS-Players are broken down by 2-year age groups and by gender when possible. Friends, teams kept together.

TAILOR MADE-Our camp curriculum is designed to allow our coaches to adjust the skills depending on the player's age and abilities.

PICK-UP: Parents should arrive 5 minutes before the end of the session. No child will be dismissed with another camper unless Parent has given a written notice to the Camp Director.

RAIN: In the event of rain there will be a 1 hour delay policy, similar to tournaments. All decisions will be made at the site and by the Camp Director. Additional time will be added to subsequent camp days, when possible to make up for lost time. There are no per hour or per diem refunds.

REFUNDS: A maximum of 50% of camp fee may be refundable up to the day the camp begins. Returned checks will be charged an additional fee of \$10.

CONFIRMATION: Please note that you will not receive any written confirmation. Please keep this top half for future reference and/or questions you may have. Players should show up on the first day of camp at 8:45 AM for July Camp and 3:45 PM for Aug Camp to allow time to check in.
