The High School Camp is available to individuals  
grades 8 to 12. This is a comprehensive camp. The  
format of this camp has been developed to provide  
detailed instruction on the offensive and defensive  
fundamentals of the game. This camp will give players  
exposure to college-level coaching and evaluation.

## YOUTH GROUP

The Youth Camp is available to players from grades 1-7.  
Individual instruction on the fundamentals and  
techniques of throwing, hitting, bunting, fielding, base  
running and baseball strategy will be covered in this  
two day camp. The format will include lectures,  
demonstrations and a wide variety of individual  
practice drills and techniques.
