North Iowa Soccer Club (NISC)

The North Iowa Soccer Club is a member organization of the Iowa Soccer Association. Player ages range from 6 to 18. Players registered with the NISC are from Mason City, Garner, Clear Lake, O Sage and others in North Iowa. The NISC has two seasons of play, Fall and Spring. Players may elect to play in one or both seasons. The focus of The NISC is to improve individual player skills and also develop team work. Teams formed as described below. The age groups currently are U 8, U 10, U 12, U 14, U 16/U 19. There are 4 players per side on U 8 teams, 6 players per side on U 10 teams, 8 players a side on U 12 teams and 11 players a side on U 14, and 6 players a side on U 16/U 19 teams. Teams may also travel to play teams from other clubs or, if parents agree, may play in recreational tournaments, such as Winter/Summer Iowa Games.

Coaches are supported with coaching clinics provided through the Iowa Soccer Association. Courses for coaches start with a basic 4 hour course. Coaches can develop their skills further with additional courses.

NISC Recreation Team Formation

- 1.) Players are assigned (rostered) to a team by random draw from one (1) player pool on a territorial basis.
- 2.) Players that live in communities without enough players to form a team shall be incorporated within the nearest town.
- 3.) Teams shall be reform ed every fall, and stay together for the spring season.
 - a. Players will be placed into the following age groups: U 8, U 10, U 12, U 14, U 16/U 19.
 - b. Teams will not be form ed into single age groups, i.e. U 9, U 11, U 12, U 13, U 15 etc.
 - c. Two consecutive age groups may be com bined if any specific age group does not have enough players to form a team .
 - d. Players shall play w ithin their appropriate age group .
 - e. If team s don't have enough players, team s will be form ed by com bining genders
- 4.) Age groups will have team s form ed w ith an attempt to have the sam e am ount of players on each team .
- 5.) Players added to an age group after team s have been form ed will be added to the team w ith the few est am ount of players, then random ly added to the rest of team s.
- 6.) Coaches shall be random ly assigned to a team after team form ation
 - a. Should the coach's child not be on his/her team , the coach may request to have his/her child rostered on his/her team .
 - b. Should the coach's child need to be re-rostered onto his/her team , the player will be traded at random w ith a player already rostered on the coach's team .

Refund Policy:

There are no refunds given once the team is registered with Iowa Soccer Association.

Exception: Teams are form ed based on the age of the player per the rules established by the Iowa Soccer Association. Teams are generated random ly (via com puter). Each team must have a coach, a team parent or assistant coach. Should the club not receive enough volunteers for coach's and team parents, players will be waitlisted based on the date that their registration form was received postmarked by the club until such time that additional volunteers step forward. Should volunteers not step forward to support the program , any waitlisted players will have their registration fees refunded in full.
