3-Position Smallbore (3PSB), Air Pistol and International Air Rifle are USA Shooting sanctioned and will be conducted using USA Shooting Rules.

Please note:

- an introductory level equipment class will be offered for Smallbore prone and 3-Position Smallbore.
- Sporter Prone Air Rifle: a 10 meter, 60 shot sporter air rifle event offers Novice and Open categories using Sporter class equipment as defined by the current National Standard Three Position Air Rifle Rules.

All competitors are encouraged to be members of USA Shooting, CMP, and NRA.

**REGISTRATION FORMS:** A registration form is included with this program. Please make as many copies as you need, fill out one **legibly**, for **each** competitor, and return it to reserve your entries. The address is included on the entry form. Space is limited and will be first paid, first reserved. Please pre-register to ensure you have a spot reserved. Relays and/or events may be canceled due to lack of preregistration. If you do not register by the deadline it is your responsibility to confirm event availability.

**AWARDS:** There must be a *minimum of five* Competitors in a category to receive awards.

**EQUIPMENT AND AMMUNITION:** Equipment may be checked randomly. All ammunition, clothing, and equipment must comply with current shooting rules for the particular event. Standard velocity .22 LR ammunition only for all smallbore events.

**TARGET PACKS:** Target Packs provided at registration for each match.

**CHALLENGES:** A scoring challenge fee of \$3.00 per Orion scored individual target is in effect. Circle the target number associated with each individual target to be challenged. The challenge period will be announced after each relay.

## 3P Smallbore Match (3PSB)

This is an indoor 50-foot, 3X20 match. **There is a standard Precision class and a new Sporter class using equipment as defined in the CMP Guide to Rimfire Sporter (iron sights only – NO scopes).** Spot checks of equipment may be conducted by Match Officials as needed. This Smallbore event will be at the following times.

**9:00 am**

- **Conduct of Match-** All Athletes will compete as individuals (no coaching on the line). USA Shooting rules shall apply.
- **Course of Fire-** 3X20 USA Shooting Rules. 20 shots in each position of prone, standing and kneeling.
- **Ammunition-** Standard velocity .22 LR ammunition only.
- **Eligibility-**This match is open to individuals.
- **Entry Fees-** \$20 per individual Athlete. All competitors are encouraged to be members of USA Shooting. Membership is available via the USA Shooting web site at [www.usashooting.com](http://www.usashooting.com).
- **Awards-** There must be a minimum of five Competitors in a category to receive award.

**New Sporter Class:** There will be two Sporter classes added to this event: Stock Sporter & Open Sporter. Stock Sporter will be CMP Rimfire legal rifles and equipment; Open Sporter will allow rifles sold by CMP which exceed the weight limitation in the CMP Guide to Rimfire Sporter. Iron sights only – NO scopes.



## Sporter Prone Air Rifle (SPAR)

This is a 10 meter, 60 shot air rifle event. This event offers Novice and Open categories using Sporter class equipment as defined by the current National Standard Three Position Air Rifle Rules. This match is normally run concurrently with an International Air Rifle relay using the same timing.

**12:30pm**

- **Eligibility-** Open to individuals (Open & Novice)
- **Conduct of Match-** All Athletes will compete as individuals. Coaching allowed for Novice athletes only until first record shot is fired.
- **Course of Fire** -Sixty shots prone air rifle for men and women in three 25 minute blocks plus sighters at the beginning of each 20 shot group. Preparation time starts 10 minutes before the scheduled match time.
- **Entry Fees-** \$10 per individual Athlete. All competitors are encouraged to be USA Shooting members. Membership is available via the USA Shooting web site at [www.usashooting.com](http://www.usashooting.com).
- **Awards:** There must be a minimum of five Competitors in a category to receive award.

## Open International Standing Match (SAR)

This is a 10 meter, 60 shot air rifle event for men and women. This event offers Sporter as well as Precision Competition. This event will be offered at the following times

**12:30 pm**

- **Conduct of Match**-All Athletes will compete as individuals (no coaching on the line). USA Shooting Rules will apply.
- **Course of Fire** -Sixty shots standing air rifle for men and women in three 25 minute blocks plus sighters at the beginning of each 20 shot group. Preparation time starts 10 minutes before the scheduled match time.
- **Entry Fees**- \$20 per individual Athlete. \$20 per individual Athlete. All competitors are encouraged to be members of USA Shooting. Membership is available via the USA Shooting web site at [www.usashooting.com](http://www.usashooting.com).
- **Awards**- There must be a minimum of five Competitors in a category to receive award.

## Open Air Pistol Match (AP)

This is a 10 meter, 60 shot Air Pistol event for men and women.  
This event will be available at the following times.

**12:30pm**

- **Conduct of Match-** All Athletes will compete as individuals (no coaching on the line). USA Shooting rules shall apply.
- **Course of Fire-** Sixty shots plus sighters Air Pistol for men and women (1 hr. 45 min.). Orion targets will be used on a retrieval system. Competitors will fire 2 record shots per target.
- **Entry Fees-** \$20 per individual Athlete. All competitors are encouraged to be USA Shooting members.

**12:30 pm**

- **Conduct of Match**– Each Athlete must have a coach on the line. Current NRA BB Gun rules shall apply.

- **Course of Fire**–

  - 4X10 NRA BB Gun Rules.

  - 2 minute prep period before prone.

  - 10 shots in each position of prone (10 minutes), standing (10 minutes), sitting (10 Minutes), and kneeling (10 minutes).

- **Eligibility**–This match is open to individuals (Open as well as Juniors).

- **Entry Fees**– \$10 per individual Athlete. All team members also compete as individuals.

- **Awards**– There must be a minimum of five Competitors in a category to receive award.

**Groups/Categories:** There are different age groups for competitors (based on athlete age as of Dec.31, 2017).
