FAQ

1. What do I need for registration?

-Completed **Player Registration Form**

--Check made payable to OSLL (\$85 for one player, \$150 for two or more players)

2. What are the boundaries of the OSLL district?

North – Fort Bayou Bridge / Along Fort Bayou (St. Martin not in the district)

South – Mississippi Sound (St. Andrews and Gulf Park Estates are in the district)

East – Mississippi / Alabama State Line (Gautier and Pascagoula are in the district)

West – Biloxi Bay (Biloxi and D'Iberville not in the district)

3. What equipment does my child need to participate?

OSLL receives a discount at Dick's Sporting Goods. See www.OSLL.org for details

Glove

Practice Pants

Baseball Cleats (not metal spikes)

Batting Helmet---Face Mask Optional

Purchasing a bat is optional-----Make sure it is Little League approved

4. When and how do players try out? (All Players Will Attend Tryouts)

Tryout dates and times are given at Registration

At tryouts, each child will field ground balls, throw to first base, take a turn at bat and run the bases while coaches evaluate their ability.

5. When will my child be selected for a team? I have siblings in same Division?

Draft dates and times are given at Registration

A Coach will contact you after the Draft (usually within a week)

IF YOU PARTICIPATE IN TRYOUTS, YOU WILL BE DRAFTED

Note: Siblings are placed on the same team. Please note Sibling on Registration Form to help us identify siblings in the same division.

6. When will we practice?

Practice begins immediately following the draft date. Each team is given time slots 2-3 times per week at the fields during the week nights and on Saturday. Coaches may schedule additional practices at an alternate site. The amount of practice depends on the individual coach. You should be prepared to participate on week nights and Saturday for the entire season.

7. When will we play games? (Go to www.OSLL.org for schedules)

Each team is schedule for one to two games per week on week nights. Some make up games may be played on Saturday. The regular season ends the last week of school. You should plan to be available on week nights and Saturday during the 8 week season.

8. What if I can not make a game or practice?

Please, please notify the coach in advance. If a team can not field 9 players due to school functions, the game can be rescheduled. Either way, the coach needs to know.

9. Uniforms and attire for games?

You will get uniforms the week of Opening Day. Uniforms consist of socks, pants, belt, jersey (last name on the back) and a cap. We recommend purchasing a long sleeve undershirt for cool nights and gnats. The coach may tell you what color so everyone matches.

10. Pictures?

Each team will take pictures at Opening Day. You will take individual and team pictures. You can purchase several packages. Pictures will be delivered to your team at a later date. We do not schedule make up dates for pictures.

11. What if I want to Coach my own Team?

Sign up at Registration making sure you designate MANAGER. You will need a copy of your Driver's License and a completed Volunteer Form.

12. What if I want to assist in coaching?

Sign up at Registration making sure you designate ASSISTANT. You will need a copy of your Driver's License and a completed Volunteer Form.

13. What if my child wants to play in the older age division?

Note this request across the top of the Player Registration Form
Attend both tryouts (Your Age Division and the Division you wish to play)
OSLL Board will notify you of approval based on the Coach Evaluations
