

Owens Center Unsupervised Minors Policy

- Minors should be directly supervised by parent / guardian at all times. Direct supervision implies that the child is within the sight of parent / guardian in the same activity area at all times.
- Owens Center staff assumes no responsibility in the supervision of minors while in our facility. Parents / Guardians are legally responsible for the conduct of their child while in Owens Center.
- As a public facility, people may enter and exit in various locations at all times. Although committed to providing a safe environment, Owens Center is not a closed environment and staff cannot monitor every person who enters or exits our facility and with whom. Parents / Guardians are responsible for the safety of their children and who they interact with while in our facility.
- Stick and puck / ball activities are not allowed in any off-ice areas of Owens Center. This includes hallways, locker-rooms, Rec Rooms, lobby, and open areas adjacent to Rink 1 or Rink 2.
- Profanity, hitting, pushing, and other disrespectful behavior toward Owens Center staff and patrons will not be tolerated.
- Unsafe or inappropriate behavior will result in the child being asked to leave the activity area.
