All images are available for purchase as prints and/or specialty items like magnets and "magazine covers". I can also produce wall clings (like "Fatheads" as seen on TV) and other products if you are interested. Best of all, a portion of proceeds will be donated back to your league.

To view images, visitors are asked to sign in using an email address; I want to assure you this is only used to distribute event related information. For example, all visitors receive an email one week before images expire to remind them of the deadline.

I will be photographing every team at least once this season. I will do my best to email coaches prior to shooting a game so you know when I will be there. I will also have a canopy set up with a display, business cards and sample images at each game I shoot. I do my best to capture all of the players, but if you are especially interested in photos, please let me know your players # before the game and I will make an extra effort.
