Longstreth/NFHCA Division II All-America Team Announced

CHANDLER, Ariz. – Thirty-two student-athletes were selected to the Longstreth/National Field Hockey Coaches Association (NFHCA) Division II All-America Team announced on Monday, including 15 who made the squad for at least the second time.

The first-team All-America squad included 10 players who participated in the NCAA Division II Field Hockey Championship. Millersville had three representatives on the list in seniors Taylor Parker and Margaret Thorwart as well as sophomore Aliza Mizak. National champion Shippensburg had a pair of first-team honorees in senior Taylor Fisher and sophomore Ally Mooney, while East Stroudsburg had seniors Emily Howell and Desiraye Mack on the first team. LIU Post sophomore Emily Miller, Saint Anselm senior Elizabeth Alie and Stonehill sophomore Kacie Smith also made the squad after their team reached the NCAA Tournament. The rest of the first team included West Chester senior Dayle Paustian and junior Rachal Toppi, Merrimack sophomore Mary McNeil, Bloomsburg senior Samantha Peters, Adelphi senior Lena Pollich and Lindenwood senior Tara Robben.

The second-team All-America list included Bloomsburg seniors Lindsay Cassel and Eleanor Kirby, Saint Anselm senior Katherine Sears and junior Erin Collins, Stonehill seniors Sarah Morse and Shea Healy, East Stroudsburg seniors Morgan Firestine and Robin Stevenson, Adelphi senior Rachel Colvin, Assumption senior Andrea Koslowski, West Chester senior Marnie Kusakavitch, Slippery Rock senior Megan McKay, LIU Post senior Stephanie Mocerino, Shippensburg junior Brooke Sheibley, Limestone senior Kathleen Sigwart and Kutztown senior Courtney Ueberroth.

Toppi became a three-time All-American, making the first team for the second time. Her fellow West Chester senior, Kusakavitch, also made the All-America list for the third year in a row. Howell, Mack and Paustian repeated as first-team selections, while Alie, Colvin, McNeil, Mizak, Parker, Pollich, Morse, Cassel, McKay and Mooney each made the All-America squad for the second time.
