West Chester's Toppi Named Longstreth/NFHCA Division II Player of the Year

CHANDLER, Ariz. – West Chester junior forward Rachal Toppi was selected as the Longstreth/National Field Hockey Coaches Association (NFHCA) Division II National Player of the Year, it was announced on Tuesday.

Toppi was previously named the Longstreth/NFHCA Division II Atlantic Region Player of the Year and a Longstreth/NFHCA First-Team All-American. She earned All-America status for the third time in as many seasons at West Chester. She also took home the Offensive Player of the Year award from the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC).

Toppi led all of Division II with 24 goals and 53 points. She has registered at least 22 goals in each of her first three seasons.

Toppi is the first Player of the Year from a PSAC school since Millersville senior Rachel Dickinson claimed the honor in 2014, and the first junior to win the award since Shippensburg's Brianna White captured the first of two consecutive honors in 2012. Toppi is also the second recipient from West Chester in the past five years after Brynn Adams won the award in 2011.
